You can choose from the following support categories:

- health and wellbeing (e.g. managing mental health, coping with difficulties, positive parenting and juggling parental demands, building your community connections and supports, fitness for work, healthy living and nutrition, exercise, diet and sleep)
- pre-vocational skills development (e.g. readiness for change counselling, career planning and tailored action plans, work preparedness, building a sense of self, aspirations and motivation, targeted goal setting and understanding the world of work)
- vocational/career development (e.g. employability skills, accredited training, overcoming barriers to work, job brokerage, job search support, volunteer work and work experience placements).

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### Our Mentors

Mentoring is entrenched in our service delivery from beginning to end.

Our mentors have local networks and can introduce you to employers, education institutions, and health and welfare providers in the region. Our mentors will support you to improve your work readiness skills and enhance your chances of obtaining employment or further training.

We have a qualified Indigenous mentor, as well as another mentor who specialises in Indigenous clients.
